- Have ongoing professional indemnity insurance and provide evidence of this cover annually at the time of renewal.
- Registered with a recognized professional body such as BAAC, BMAS or the AACP
- Proven experience in a similar role where possible.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to work flexible hours, including evenings and weekends.
- An enhanced DBS certificate issued within 6 months of commencement date.
