PGCERT SPOP ADDITIONAL COURSE COSTS

Students should be aware that there may be other course costs in addition to course fees. Some of the potential costs you may need to consider are provided in the table below, but please note that this is not an exhaustive list.

Accommodation & Living Costs (The UCO does not currently provide accommodation but can offer advice and support here: https://www.uco.ac.uk/life-uco/location-and-accommodation/accommodation.)	Costs vary dependent on your choice of accommodation and suppliers.
A Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) enhanced check at the point of registration for your course available from the UCO.	£50.00
Locker Key (Optional should you wish to have the use of a locker at the UCO.)	£10.00 (Refunded when you no longer require the locker or are no longer a student of the UCO.) £10.00 (non-refundable) is payable to replace a lost locker key.
Student Card (You will be given a UCO Student Card at no charge at the point of registration.)	£10.00 (non-refundable) is payable to replace a lost UCO Student Card.
Textbooks Our library is well stocked with all the textbooks you should need, but you may prefer to buy your own.	Costs vary dependent on your choice of book and supplier.
Computer / Laptop / Storage Devices (Our ITC Suite contains desktop computers and printers for you to use, however you may wish to purchase your own computer / printer / storage devices at your own cost.)	Costs vary dependent on your choice of model and supplier.
Travel To & From the UCO	Costs vary dependent on the form of transport and the distance travelled.
Travel Between the UCO and Clinics (Most of our clinics are within walking or cycling distance from the UCO Teaching and Clinical Centres)	Costs vary depending on the form of transport and the distance travelled.

<p>PPE</p> <p>You are required to wear PPE in line with UCO Policy.</p> <p>The UCO will provide you with PPE, however if you wish to wear goggles rather than a visor you may purchase this yourself – available from various suppliers)</p>	<p>Costs vary dependent on your choice of supplier.</p>
<p>Vaccinations</p> <p>(All osteopathic students are strongly advised to be immunised against Covid-19, Hepatitis B and to ensure that your immunisations against Polio, TB, Tetanus, MMR, Diphtheria and Varicella are up to date).</p>	<p>Charged at NHS Prices.</p>
<p>Printing / Photocopying</p> <p>The UCO provides you with a number of photocopying / printing credits per year however once you exceed this number you will need to pay for these costs yourself as per our normal costs.</p>	<p>UCO Printing / Photocopying Costs.</p>
<p>Refreshments / Lunch</p> <p>The UCO does not offer a full canteen service but does provide students with free filtered water, tea, coffee, milk and kitchen facilities to prepare your own food.</p> <p>There are also plenty of café's and supermarkets close to the UCO where can purchase food and drink.</p>	<p>Costs vary dependent on your choice of supplier.</p>
